Subject: Chamber Meeting Minutes – June 2, 2008

1. The Cedarville Area Chamber Of Commerce met on June 2, 2008 at the Cedarville Senior Citizen's Center at 7:00 p.m.
2. Attendees: Christi Cox, Dr. David Baits, Lori Harris, Sherman Mackereth, Jane Mills, Heather Fox, Betty Baldwin, Chuck & Letha Kimball, Lisa Schroeder, Don Miller and guests Craig & Taylor Minor, Gary R. Everhart and Kristin Miller.
3. Approval of the May 2008 Meeting Minutes: The Minutes were approved as read.
4. Treasure's Report: No report given.
5. Craig and Taylor Minor's Presentation on Their New Business: The Stoney Creek Roasters will be located at 83 N. Main St. It will provide many types of roasted coffee beans whole sale, including customized blends. There will be coffee tasting and internet sales of roasted coffee beans. Many kinds of coffee, chocolate drinks and fruit drinks will be on sale along with sandwiches. Tentatively it will open October 1st, 2008, Monday through Saturday, from 7:00 am to 11:00 pm. The remaining building and apartments are also being renovated. There will be several store fronts available.
6. Memorial Day Parade: The Memorial Day Parade was a real success. Betty Baldwin is sending out ~56 thank you cards to the various groups and the individual veterans that were in the parade. There was a miscommunication between Studio B, the company that made the beautiful signs, and Betty Baldwin. The Executive Board agreed to pay an additional \$200 to Studio B, but will hold a corn hole tournament on July 19, to help repay the debt. This motion was made by Betty Baldwin and second by Lisa Schroeder to pay the \$200 to Studio B; motion passed.
7. Fireworks Funding: Chuck and Letha Kimball have put out the letters and buckets to the area businesses. \$532 has come in so far. That is only a tenth of the goal the Chamber has set. Good job Kimballs! There will be a fund raising spaghetti dinner for the fireworks July 19th from 4 to 7 pm at the Grace Baptist Church Gym. Tickets are \$7 for ages 12 and up; \$5 for ages 5-11, \$3 for ages 3-4, and
